Temptation Truths

> Doing right <u>doesn't make me immune from temptation.</u>

His master recognized that GOD was with him, saw that GOD was working for good in everything he did. Genesis 39:3 (MSG)

➤ There's a positive and negative side to temptation.

Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death. James 1:15 (NIV)

Sometime later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. Genesis 22:1 (NIV)

> Temptation ALWAYS <u>calls for a decision</u>.

No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it. 1 Corinthians 10:13

Temptation Instructions

1. Don't put yourself in the place of temptation.

She kept putting pressure on Joseph, day after day, but he refused to sleep with her, and he kept out of her way as much as possible. Genesis 39:10 (NLT)

Instead, live like the Lord Jesus Christ did, and forget about satisfying the desires of your sinful nature. Romans 13:14 (Good News Translation)

2. Value the presence of God.

But the LORD was with Joseph in the prison and showed him his faithful love. And the LORD made Joseph a favorite with the prison warden. Gen. 39:21 (NLT)

Then, because you belong to Christ Jesus, God will bless you with peace that no one can completely understand. And this peace will control the way you think and feel. Philippians 4:7

3. Soak yourself *in God's word daily.*

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. Psalm 119:11 (NIV)

4. Make a commitment to God's standards.

"How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word." Psalm 119:9 (NLT)

"It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable. 1 Thessalonians 4:3-4 (NIV)
